Ideas are richly supported with accurate details that develop the main point. The author's voice is evident. Still, a close reading and at least attempted analysis of poems are undeniable.
4.	The thesis displays critical thinking and avoids simplistic description or summary of information. Still, it is a bachelor thesis which with respect to the amount of research and complexity of the issue, is likely to meet the required criteria stated in vyhláška děkanky VD 11/2012, in the sense, that these shortcomings do not prevent proper understanding of the thesis ideas.
