Then she focuses her attention on course books in connection with the pictorial materials. I appreciate that these two areas are discussed together. Moreover, pedagogical and psychological aspects about the researched teenage group are provided. This theoretical framework brings an excellent base for the future research.
3. The methodology chapter provides clear and thorough description of the research methodology. It discusses why and what methods were chosen for research. The research methodology is appropriate for the identified research questions. The research tool, a semi-structured interview, seems appropriate to the nature of the investigation.
4. The results/data are analyzed and interpreted effectively. The chapter ties the theory with the findings. It addresses the applications and implications of the research. It discusses strengths, weaknesses, and limitations of the research.
